# A Small Town in a Big City

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- Center Line is about 2 square miles, surrounded by the city of Warren
- Home to about 8,300 residents
- 230 businesses and corporations support the community's lifestyle
- Economy is primarily based on manufacturing, retail, transportation and construction
- The median household income is below the state average
- About three quarters of the adults in the community have a high school diploma
- Roughly 6% of adults hold a bachelors degree and 1% have a graduate level degree
- The district is becoming increasingly rich in diversity

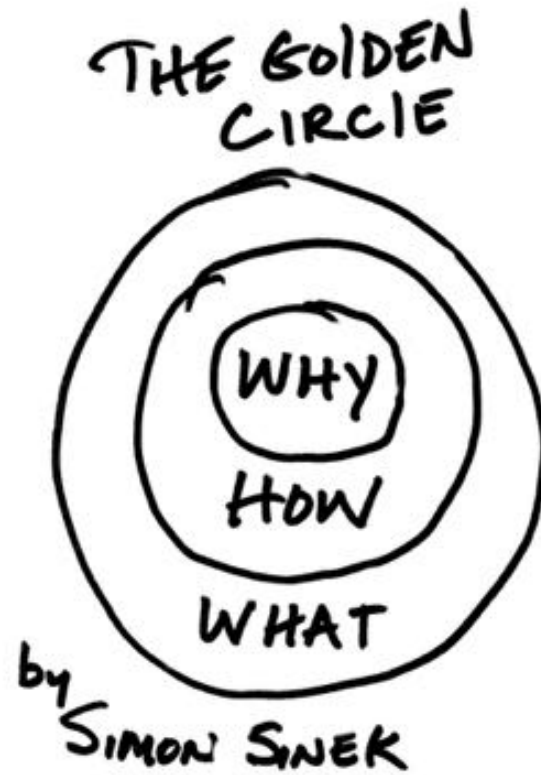
# Our Students

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- Service about 3000 students from Center Line and sections of Warren, MI
- Schools include an early childhood center, three elementary schools, one middle school, one traditional high school and Academy 21, a hybrid school, and we authorize a charter school for 18-26 year olds with cognitive impairments – Rising Stars Academy, a farm to plate culinary program
- Demographic breakdown of students:
  - 57% white, 21% black, 11% Asian, 9% Multi-racial and 1% Hispanic
- Free and reduced lunch rates:
  - School rates range from 64% - 81%

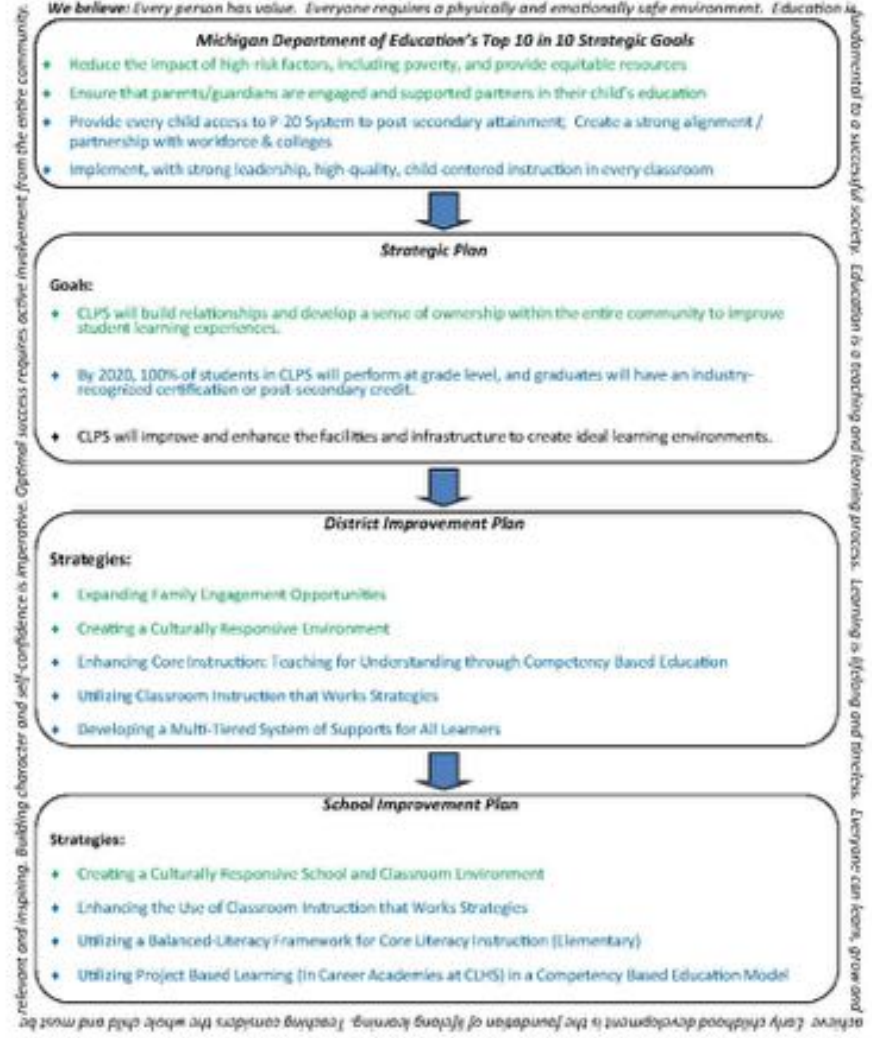
